

# KX Tieback Receptacle

KX Oil Tools Tieback Receptacle is a tool that is typically run as a part of the liner hanger assembly and is used to release from the hanger once run or to run and retrieve workover or production string from the wellbore.

The KX Tieback Receptacle has a right hand release running thread incorporated into the body of the tool that allows the KX Latch Seal Nipple to rotate the liner in compression through the castellations in the receptacle and also release the KX Latch Seal Nipple from the receptacle in slight tension.

This simple design is suitable for cemented liner systems, and is strong enough to convey frac liners in place, and perform the stimulation program.
